



Confound#1 US Supreme Court




6-3 conservative super majority

Active small government, deregulation stance

May declare some maximum regulations unconstitutional, or exceeding the authority of the relevant regulators



Confound#2 Not every country is a democracy (looking at you, China!)



The public opinion is not a direct driver of regulatory action, but more an Overton Window limiting what can be done.

The dictators balance the interest of the direct stakeholders based on their own interest and philosophy Possible legal outcomes by 2025



Wild guess or science?

Method used in academia

Good judgement project

2400 Americans of wide demographic and expertise level surveyed

Log-odds weighted averaging

Experts assigned more weight based on research evidence

Most accurate forecasters likely

Have advanced degree

Good general political language

High score in mental openess

Our limitation:

Using only synthetic and public data

Having only few hours of time

Forecasting panel too small and lack diversity
